Definitions:

Texture: In photography texture refers to the visual quality of the surface of an object, revealed through variances in shape, tone and colour depth. Texture brings life and vibrance to images that would otherwise appear flat and uninspiring.

Winter: Wintery cold places offer myriad opportunities for **photography**, and if the light is right, you can get some truly fantastic shots, but other subjects can also conjure up the feeling of winter...winter clothing, warm fires, etc

Panning: **Panning** is a photographic technique that combines a slow shutter speed with camera motion to create a sense of speed around a moving object. It is a way to keep your subject in focus while blurring your background. **Panning** is typically done on a subject moving horizontally, such as a moving car, or a running dog.

Long Exposure: Long-exposure, time-exposure, or slow-shutterphotography involves using a long-duration shutter speed to sharply capture the stationary elements of images while blurring, smearing, or obscuring the moving elements.
