Definitions:

Nature's Curves: Curves are Nature's secret weapon..from the human form to vast landscapes, from minute details in a flower to thundering waves..seek them out and show us their beauty.

A Story in 2: Use two related images to tell a story.

Fun Portrait: Cheeky kids, crazy moments...capture the mischief, laughter, fun of the moment.

Australia and Australiana: Iconic images of the land we live in, its people and objects relating to its history or culture.

Weathered: Seasoned, or otherwise affected by exposure to the weather.

Animals: A living creature that can move at will. Can be domestic, wild, in a zoo, but not a bird, insect or reptile.

Clocks and/or Watches: Can be a straight or creative image of a timepiece, or one where the clock face plays an important role in the interpretation of the image.

Festival: Christmas, Easter, Australia Day, Anzac Day, the Elvis Festival, Autumn Colours Festival, Winter Festival, Vivid, Poetry Festivals, Spring Racing Festivals, Chinese New Year, Mardi Gras etc.

Using Blue: The colour Blue must play an important role in the image.

Shadows: Have fun with shadows..an experiment with tone, line, pattern, simplicity, complexity. One shadow, many shadows, shadows that tell a story.
